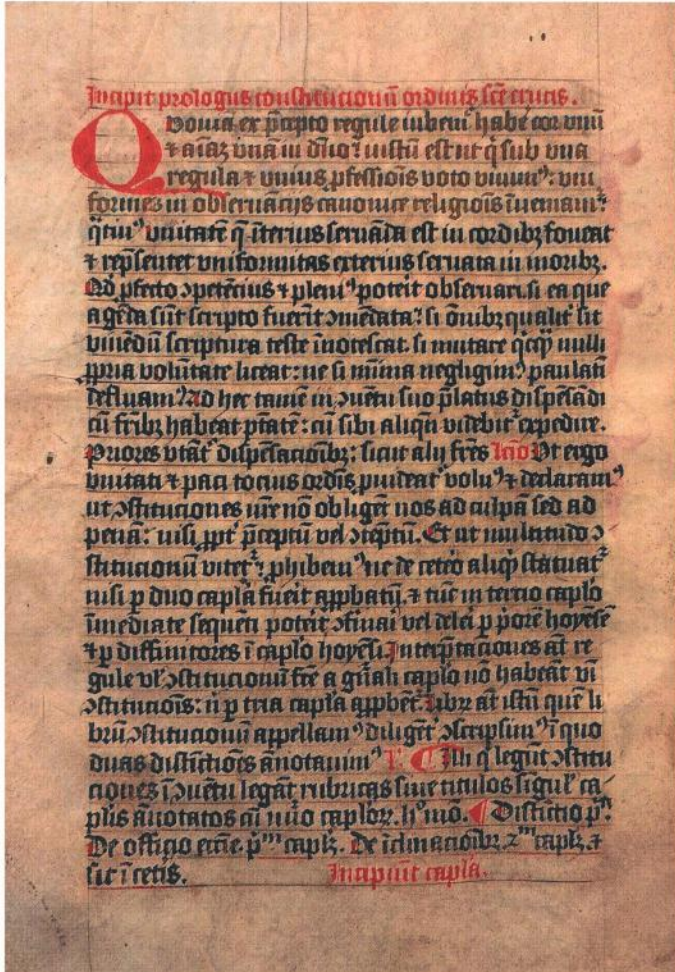


In the 15th Century, the Brethren of the Holy Cross geared themselves to a sacramental-ascetical religious life
